24.1	1	Apologies for absence: It was RESOLVED that apologies were received from Cllr Jackson
24.2	2	Declarations of Pecuniary Interest and Requests for Dispensation It was RESOLVED that there were no declarations of pecuniary interest.
24.3	3	Minutes of the Last Meeting: It was RESOLVED that the council confirmed the minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on the 6th November 2023. The Chair signed the minutes.
24.4	4	Public Participation: There were 3 members of the public present: Drains at Longfield.  Before Christmas a wheelbarrow of debris was cleared from the stormwater drain after the first rain - this helped the flow. Surface water from the road builds up. Another half a wheelbarrow load was removed after the very heavy rain. This is not helped by the fact that the water from the other side of the road - ditch is not deep enough - surface/storm water sits over the sewer manhole, the system becomes overwhelmed and Longfield can't use their toilets. There are springs in the neighbouring field which have been filled in and now the water has nowhere to stand and flows onto the road. None of the drains in the village are maintained.  Letter from residents and neighbours has been sent to CDC and highways. Residents have written to the environment agency, and Clir Sudbury replied that the ditch was the responsibility of the land owner.  In Dashwood Rise the 2 drains are full of mud. Roads are not cleared of leaves etc which accumulate in the drains.  The Middle Barton Road drain is flooded too.  It was RESOLVED that the Chair would try and speak to the landowners about maintenance of the hedge and ditch.  It was RESOLVED that the Parish Council would include drain clearing as part of the village tidy up day and ask CDC for big wheelie bins to collect all the debris.  Planning application on Main Street - Mrs Fowler.  Pearl and Don were left the land to built a house to retire to. Next generation would now like to build a house to retire to. Land has a lot of family history and they would like to be back in the village.  The planning response from 2021 referred to and the Council made it clear that those issues would need to be address before anything will be approved. In addition to which this is not regarded as infill space and is between historic buildings in the centre of the conservation area - Manor House, Dove Cote, Manor Farm House and Daisy Hill.  Mrs Fowler said some changes had been made:  the wall should now look
