Charity of the Quarter

For August/September/October, the PCC will be collecting donations to help the work of Polly who befriends the homeless in Banbury. Her work was recognised in this year's High Sheriff of Oxfordshire Awards.

Polly distributes food and befriends the homeless in the Banbury area every day.

- Polly has been working for over 26 years now in the centre of Banbury, providing food every evening, plus cakes/sandwiches etc for the people to take for the next day.
- Polly helps the friendless and also people recently out of hospital or prison, as well as the homeless – anyone who needs love and guidance as well as food.

Polly is very appreciative of all your donations, whether food or money. She goes into town every day at 2pm to collect surplus sandwiches from Banjos sandwich delivery service. She then has to return home on the bus to finish off the dinners and is out again at 4.30 to St Mary's churchyard to give her group of homeless people the food and drinks she has prepared.

She is planning to take her group of people on the train to Stratford over the next month.

Reminder: When leaving donated food in the basket in church, please make sure all food is still within its use-by date.
