Adults Classes:

- 1 Men's Lemon Cake
- 2 Flower Arrangement in a 400g baked bean can

Children's Classes:

- 3 Garden on a Plate - Primary School Age Group
- 4 Garden on a Plate - Secondary School Age Group
- 5 Animal made out of Vegetables - Primary School Age Group
- 6 Animal made out of Vegetables - Secondary School Age Group

Description of Classes:

- Class 1** A single cake. Anything you like so long as its lemony and delicious. It will be judged on both taste and appearance. Please note a small slice will be cut to taste.
- Class 2** Arrangement to include some, if not all, fresh material. To be in a standard 400g baked bean tin which can be decorated.
- Classes 3/4** This can be any kind of garden, made using whatever materials you like. Maximum plate size is a standard dinner plate (approx 27cm/10.5"). Paper plates are fine.
- Classes 5/6** The animal can be any size. It should be 3D, freestanding and broadly recognisable.

RULES:

We don't want to have too many. But please:

- * bring your entries on the morning of the fete to The Manor by 10.30am to the Craft Tent
- * one entry form per person
- * ensure your name is not on the actual entry
- * only enter one exhibit in each class
- * ensure that children's work is unaided as far as possible
- * men - the only woman allowed to be involved with your cakes is Mary Berry!
- * all lemon cakes will be sold after the judging unless you indicate to the contrary on the form
- * all entries not collected by 5pm on the day of the fete will be disposed of
- * entries will be judged before the fete opens. The judge's decision is final and importantly
