Scarecrow Competition Rules

How To Enter:

The Scarecrow Competition is being run as part of the Duns Tew Church Fete which this year takes place on Sunday 2nd July 2017.

Entry Form will be in June newsletter, or see Page 1 of this file on the Duns Tew Village website at: <http://www.dunstew.com/>. There will also be a small number of forms at The White Horse Inn.

Scarecrow installations must be in place and clearly visible from outside your property by 1pm on Saturday 17th June 2017 to allow time for both Judging and for maximum enjoyment of the entries of Scarecrows

Part 1 of the Entry Form and Fee must be delivered by 1pm on Friday 16th June to The White Horse Inn or Kennington House along with the Entry Fee - £2 per entry.

Part 2 of the Entry Form must be displayed alongside your Scarecrow so that the judge can see it!

JUDGING:

Judging of the scarecrow competition will take place during week beginning Monday 19th June and will be carried out by Michael from The White Horse.

The result will be announced and a luxury hamper presented to the winner at the Duns Tew Church Fete on SUNDAY 2nd July 2017.

Your scarecrow must remain on display from SATURDAY 17th June to SUNDAY 2nd July, inclusive.

Photographs of all entries will be on display at the Church Fete.

Scarecrow Competition Rules

Your scarecrow must be:

- an original piece of work and made from scratch
- in good taste and suitable for a family event
- able to withstand all weather conditions
- placed where it is visible and maintained in good order and condition throughout the display period

You must take all reasonable care and responsibility to ensure the safety of the exhibit and people approaching to view it.

General road safety must also be considered when siting your scarecrow.

You may use props and accessories to enhance your scarecrow and to provide context.

THE JUDGE'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL AND NO CORRESPONDENCE WILL BE ENTERED INTO.

Have fun – give your scarecrow a name and personality!
